## Garden of Eden Supply List

A One Day Workshop with Laura Wasilowski

### **Supplies Participants Should Bring:**

- 2 yards of regular weight Wonder-Under. Please DO NOT BRING HEAT 'N BOND or STEAM A SEAM
- Small sharp scissors. Small, 5" knife blade scissors work well
- Paper scissors
- Rotary cutter, mat and quilting ruler
- Specialty rotary cutter blades, such as Pinking, Wavy or Scallop
- Cotton batting (Hobbs Cotton Heirloom Batting recommended) 1 piece measuring about 18" x 18"
- Quilt backing fabric, 1 piece measuring about 18" x 18"
- Iron and ironing surface (share with other class members if not provided by group)
- Tweezers (optional)
- Small plastic bag for fabric scraps

**\$20 Kit Fee: Includes hand out and hand-dyed fabrics and threads.**
