## PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

Wall Quilt size: 12" x 12"

Block size: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" and 2 1/2" x 7 1/2"

Number of blocks: 7

## FABRIC & BATTING

1/8 yd brown mottled for the inner border or a color choice of your own

1/8 yd brown print for outer border or a color choice of your own

7 scraps 3" x 2" for roof pieces

7 scraps 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" for house pieces

1 scrap 3" x 1 1/2" for grass

1 scrap 1" x 3 1/2" for pole

1/4 yd tan, cream or blue sky for background

Backing 15" x 15"

Batting 15" x 15"

1 1/2 yd of self -made or purchased narrow binding

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

Sewing machine

Neutral color all-purpose thread (have a bobbin already wound for the class)

8 assorted 3/8" -1/2" brown, black or white buttons

1 cat button

Quilting foot (for your machine)

1/4" sewing foot (for your machine)

Rotary cutter, scissors, rotary cutting mat (small)

ruler

Instructor will have an assortment of scraps for your use. Fabrics can be wild & crazy or all one color but different designs or just your favorite color or a bunch of whatever scraps. This is a small project but it is VERY EASY and quick and you will be able to get it done by the end of the class. I will provide you with an additional copy of the pattern (per the creator's permission) which you can then take home with you to do another. These can not be sold for profit.
